ORDER REINSTATING
SENTENCES FOR CONTEMPT
AND ISSUANCE OF WARRANT
FOR GERALD ARMSTRONG'S
ARREST
[proposed]

19 In consideration of plaintiff Church of Scientology International's motion for
20 reinstatement of the sentences of contempt issued against defendant Gerald Armstrong
21 and for the issuance of a warrant for his arrest, and defendant Armstrong's Opposition
22 thereto, the Court rules as follows:

23 To the extent Plaintiff is requesting this Court to issue an order consistent with the
24 directions in the First District Court of Appeal decision in this matter, filed October 19,
25 2005, i.e., "To Reinstate the Sentences Previously Imposed on Armstrong for the
26 Contempt Citations of June 5, 1997 and February 20, 1998, and Reinstate the Fine on the
27 Third Contempt Citation;" and to issue a bench warrant for defendant Armstrong's arrest,
28 the motion is GRANTED.

It is hereby ORDERED that the sentences previously imposed on Armstrong for
the contempt citations of June 5, 1997 and February 20, 1998, sentencing Armstrong to 2

1 days and 26 days incarceration respectively, and the fine of \$1,000, are reinstated, and a
2 bench warrant is to be issued forthwith for Armstrong's arrest.
